



Exciting new phase of homes unveiled at Barton Park

Redrow Homes Thames Valley has unveiled plans for the next stage of stunning new homes at Barton Park called The Steeples.

Redrow is delivering 207 three and four-bedroom homes at The Steeples. The homes will be set around a series of individually designed 'pocket parks', creating opportunities for children to play and residents to socialise.

The Steeples forms part of the wider Barton Park development, a sustainable urban extension to the east of Oxford city being delivered by a partnership between Grosvenor Britain & Ireland and Oxford City Council.

When finished, Barton Park will add 885 homes to the city, 40 per cent of which will be homes for social rent to help address Oxford's housing need. The first residents have already moved into Mosaics, the first stage of the development. Barton Park is also a demonstrator site for NHS England's Healthy New Towns programme, created to explore how the built environment can encourage good health and wellbeing, and it features a new linear park and sports facilities.

Reflecting this vision, The Steeples will be designed with 21st-century garden suburb principles in mind, with stylish homes built around green space and shared amenities that are intended to support a strong sense of community.

Once the development is complete, new and existing residents in Barton will benefit from a new primary school, community hub, children's play areas, sustainable transport links and parkland – including cycling, running and walking routes. Twenty per cent of energy consumed on the development is also set to be produced by renewable sources.
